The Government introduced a new employer-led temporary work visa called the Accredited Employer Work Visa (AEWV). This involves a 3-check process. 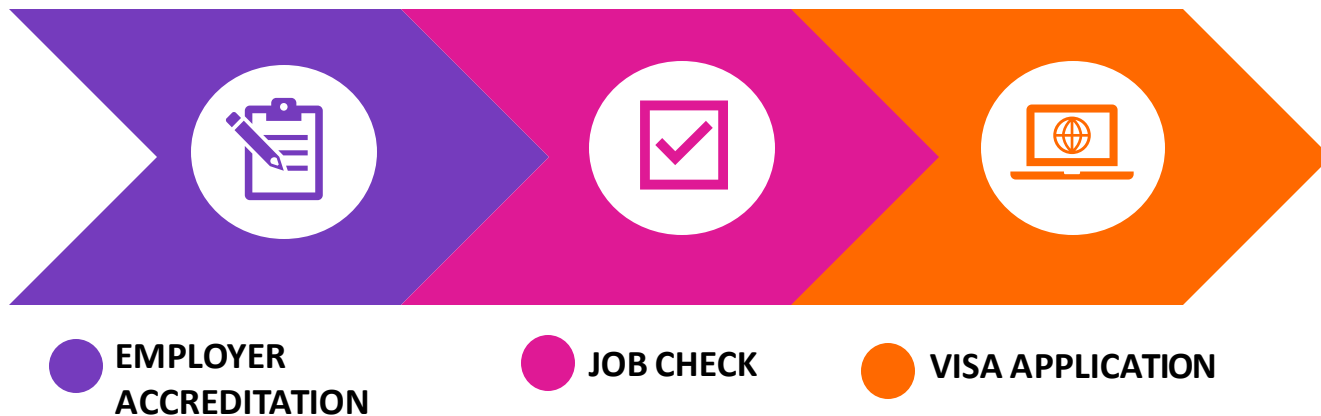
Appendix – What is the AEWV?

The Government introduced the Accredited Employer Work Visa (AEWV) to replace a number of temporary work visas. Employers need to be accredited to employ migrants on an AEWV. The process is employer-led and involves three checks – accreditation, job check and the visa application.

The AEWV will help ensure New Zealanders are first in line for jobs, reduce the risk of migrant exploitation while also providing a way for accredited employers to hire skilled migrant workers where a genuine skill or labour shortage exists for eligible jobs.
